Dear Dawn Stronstad, RPF:

Your final submission of your new management plan for Burns Lake Community Forest titled "Management Plan #2 2010-2015" dated on April 14, 2011 has been approved effective April 18, 2011. This management plan expires April 13, 2015 and may be extended, upon request, for a period of one year if progress on preparing a new management plan and timber supply analysis is shown.

In arriving at my decision to approve this management plan, I ensured the requirements of the Forest Act and its regulation, and the license document was fully met.

I reviewed the efforts to consult with First Nations to ensure that adequate consultation and accommodation efforts have been made. As part of this review, I have placed emphasis on the document: First Nations Consultation Summary K1A Management Plan #2 by Sharon Marr, RPF and the referral summary included in the management plan document itself.


An AAC determination was made as part of this management plan on February 25, 2011 by James Sayle. For clarity (with respect to the payments of annual rent and cut control calculations) the approval of this management plan includes an AAC of 260,000 m³/year effective January 1, 2011 until December 31, 2013 (with a maximum 52,000 m³/year of the total AAC coming from non-pine conifers and from January 1, 2014 onwards the AAC will be 100,000 m³/year.
